# **BANANA SQUISH SCARF**

A total beginner's pattern, if you can knit and purl, you can make this scarf, baby-sized for near-immediate satisfaction. This ribbed baby scarf features a "keyhole" solution to ensure it stays put on your little 'uns.



# **INGREDIENTS**

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Length: approx. **54 cm** (21.2"). To fit 0-12 months.

#### **YARN**

Jaeger Baby Merino DK, colour: #192, 25g (approx. 60 metres). Substitute with DK yarn.

#### **SUGGESTED NEEDLES**

4.5 mm. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge. **Optional**: 4 mm crochet hook.

#### NOTIONS

Tapestry needle.

#### GAUGE

28 sts and 22 rows = 10 cm (4") in **ribbing 2x2** NOT STRETCHED. Do bear in mind that you are making a scarf, so the gauge isn't terribly important!

### **STITCH GUIDE**

#### **RIBBING 2X2**

**Row 1:** sl 1 st pw, k1, \*p2, k2\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** sl 1 st pw, p1, \*k2, p2\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

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# **DIRECTIONS**

CO 24 sts. Beg with a ws row, work **ribbing 2x2** until scarf measures 42 cm (16.5") from CO edge, ending with a ws row

#### **MAKEKEYHOLE**

On next row (rs), continue ribbing 2x2 as est and work as follows: work 6 sts, BO 12 sts, work 6 sts.

On following row (ws), work 6 sts, CO 12 sts (using thumb method), work remaining 6 sts.

Continue **ribbing 2x2** as previously est for a further 12 cm (4.7") until scarf measures 54 cm (21.2") from CO edge. BO in pattern.

**Optional:** using the crochet hook, work one row of SC (US term: DC), along the keyhole to give it stability.

#### **FINISHING**

Using the tapestry needle, weave in ends. Lightly block to finished measurements. Give to your favourite baby to **wear and enjoy!** ③

# **ABBREVIATIONS (A-Z)**

beg=beginning; BO=bind-off (cast-off); CO=cast on;
DC=double crochet; est=established; k=knit; p=purl;
rs=right side; SC=single crochet, st(s)=stitch(es);
ws=wrong side.
