CARNIVAL BABY HAT

With funky i-cord "locks" this multi-coloured hat is super easy, making it ideal for the beginner knitter wanting to practice knitting in the round with circulars and double pointed needles. Bonus point? Minimal finishing!



INGREDIENTS

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: **40 cm** (15.7"). To fit newborn / 0-3 months.

YARN

Aran weight: MC (ie: variegated colour): 50g (approx. 115 metres); CC (ie: solid colour): 20g (approx. 45 metres).

SUGGESTED NEEDLES

5 mm (40 cm) circular & DPNs. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

Optional: 4 mm crochet hook.

NOTIONS

1 x stitch marker; tapestry needle.

GAUGE

18 sts and 26 rows = 10 cm (4") in stocking stitch.

STITCH GUIDE

STOCKING STITCH

All rnds: knit all stitches.

RIBBING 2X2

All rnds: *k2, p2*, repeat from * to * to end of rnd.

DIRECTIONS

With **circular needles** and **CC** yarn CO 72 sts. Making sure not to twist sts, pm to mark BOR, join and work in the round

Work stocking stitch for 4 rnds.

Work ribbing 2x2 for 5 rnds. K 1 rnd.

Change to **MC** yarn. Work in **stocking stitch** until body measures 12 cm (4.7") from CO edge [edge will roll approx. 1 cm (0.39")].

CROWN SHAPING

(Switch to DPNs when there are too few sts for the circulars.)

Rnd 1: *k6, k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (63 sts on needles).

Rnds 2 & 3: * k*, repeat from from * to * to end of rnd. Rnd 4: *k5, k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (54 sts on needles).

Rnds 5 & 6: * k*, repeat from from * to * to end of rnd.
Rnd 7: *k4, k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (45 sts on needles).

Rnd 8: * k*, repeat from from * to * to end of rnd.

Rnd 9: *k3, k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (36 sts on needles).

Rnd 10: *k2, k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (27 sts on needles).

Rnd 11: *k1, k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (18 sts on needles).

Rnd 12: *k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (9 sts on needles).

Rnd 13: *k2tog* repeat from * to * to end of rnd (5 sts on needles).

Rnd 14: K2tog (4 sts on needles).

SI sts onto 1 DPN.

I-CORDS LOCKS

Using 2 DPNs work a **4 sts i-cord** for approx **8 cm** (3.1"). Cut yarn leaving a **10 cm** (3.9") tail. Using the tapestry needle, weave the tail through the i-cord. Using the crochet hook and alternating between MC and CC, pu 4 sts near first i-cord and switching to 2 DPNs, repeat above process, creating as many i-cords as desired, of different lengths [example in photograph shows 11 i-cords of ranging from 4 (1.5") to 12 cm (4.7")].

FINISHING

Using the tapestry needle, weave in ends. Lightly block to finished measurements. Give to your favourite newborn to **wear and enjoy!** 😂

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ABBREVIATIONS (A-Z)

BOR=beginning of round; CO=cast on; DPN(s)=double pointed needle(s); k=knit; p=purl; pu=pick-up; rnd(s)=round(s); k2tog=knit 2 sts together; s1=slip; st(s)=stitch(es).
